

# "NATURE ALL AROUND US" ART TRAIL

The artworks are located along a circular walk starting from Bitterne Station. The whole walk takes approx. 25 minutes (1.0 mile).

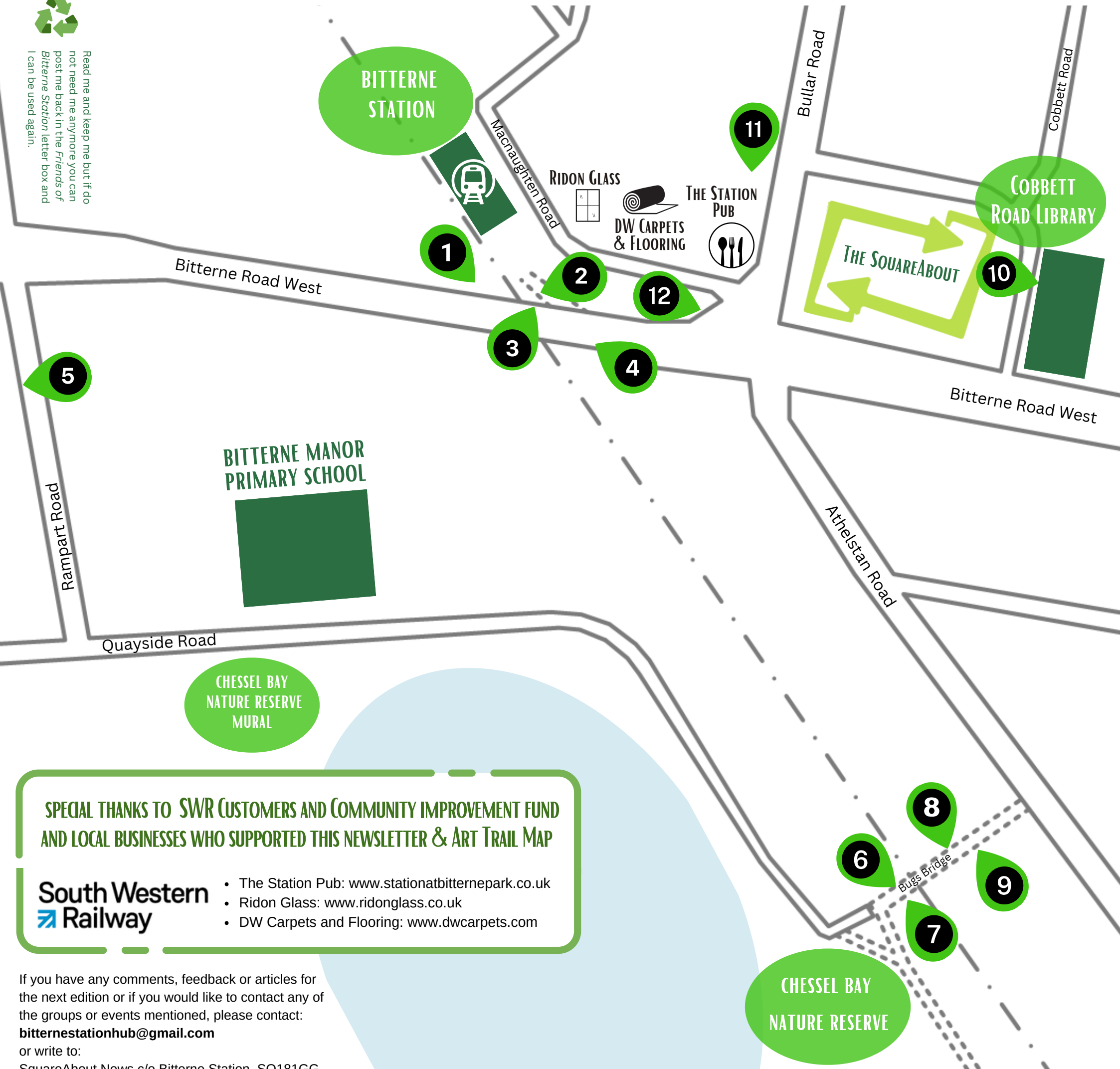
At Bitterne Station, you can enjoy two murals (1,2). Via the pedestrian ramp, reach Bitterne Road West. Alongside the railroad bridge, find two murals (3,4). Keep on walking towards Southampton city centre alongside Bitterne Road West until the next traffic light, and turn left into Rampart Road, where mural (5) is located. At the end of Rampart Road turn left and keep walking along Quayside Road, passing by Bitterne Manor Primary. Find Chessel Bay Mural opposite the school gate and enjoy the view of the bay. Continue on the pedestrian and cycle route until the entrance to Chessel Bay Local Nature Reserve.

Then, use the ramp or steps and cross the "Bugs Bridge" over the railway line where murals (6,7,8,9) are located. After crossing the bridge, admire the butterflies on the wall sponsored by the community members to support the project, and turn left onto Athelstan Road. At the end of the road, cross the traffic lights towards the SquareAbout and towards Cobbett Road Library to find a mural (10).

Walk back towards Bitterne Station, along the north side of the gyratory and find mural (11) on the north wall of The Station pub. Walk back towards the station and find the last mural (12) by the recycling area opposite the pub.
